

We keep regular contact with the foster home. This includes personal visits from Andrew Smith and other members of the management team together with emails & phone calls *to monitor* the progress of the foster Dane.

With regard to adoptive homes we also visit the new owners as a matter of course over the initial months, together with emails & phone calls. If longer term support is needed this is given.

We also organise meetings and walks where informal catching up ensues. Given T J Danes Rescue dogs are placed throughout the UK, the owners are encouraged and out in touch with, Great Dane walks in their area.

The dogs throughout their lives remain the property of T J Danes Rescue. This enables life long monitoring of each and every dog that comes through our hands. The reasoning behind this is that should the adopters/fosterers circumstances change, whereby the dog's welfare is put at risk, T J Danes will exercise its right of ownership to prioritise the dog's needs.

Examples of such situations we have experienced are

- Death of adopter
- Long term imprisonment
- Homelessness
- Change of circumstances.
